The SeaCrest Resort sits atop a 150 foot bluff overlooking the California Coastline of Pismo Beach. Golf courses, tennis courts and gourmet restaurants are located nearby, and Hearst Castle and Solvang lie within 45 miles of this property. Pismo sand dunes offer recreational opportunities,

The SeaCrest Resort's amenities include a heated outdoor pool with ocean views, barbecue area, complimentary wireless internet and a sun deck.
